OBJECTIVE:

To provide civil engineering undergraduate students an opportunity to work on a fast paced design build project. This will incorporate the teams' ability to efficiently communicate, execute and collaborate together on an unknown project.

PARTICIPANTS:

- Each school may enter one team only.
- Each team must consist of 4 members.
- Each team member must be a registered participant of the PSWC2012.
- Each team must have at least one underclassman.
- Each team must have at least one senior.
- Each team must have one member assigned as team captain.

EVENT DESCRIPTION:

Impromptu is one of the most interesting traditions at the PSWC; it tests the competitor's general engineering skills while entertaining its spectators. The event will combine the competitors' quick improvisation and decisive leadership skills.

GENERAL RULES:

1. The event is unknown to the competitors until competition day.
2. Students may only work in their pre set teams.
