

2012 ASCE PACIFIC SOUTH WEST CONFERENCE: Penny Wars

OBJECTIVE:

To create some healthy competition while raising money for a good cause. All profits will be donated to [Water For People](#).

EVENT DESCRIPTION:

The object of this game is for each school to collect as many pennies and dollar bills in their container during the “war” while simultaneously sabotaging other schools by “bombing” their containers with silver coins. Pennies and dollar bills will be worth a positive amount of points. All silver coins will be worth a negative amount of points. Everyone is allowed and encouraged to participate in this event. Strategy is key! All proceeds go to Water For People, so the more you “bomb,” the better!

GENERAL RULES:

1. Each school must bring one transparent 5-gallon water bottle with their full name clearly written on it.
2. If a school chooses to decorate their water bottle, they can decorate only **50%** of the bottle’s surface.
3. Students will put pennies and dollar bills into their school’s labeled container to gain points.
4. Students may also sabotage other schools by placing silver coins (nickels, dimes, & quarters) into their containers, resulting in the deduction of points.
5. Only American currency will be accepted.
6. NO counterfeit money will be accepted.
7. Students may **NOT** remove money from any of the containers!
8. Money value:

Penny: 1 point	1 Dollar Bill: 100 points
Nickel: -5 points	5 Dollar Bill: 500 points
Dime: -10 points	10 Dollar Bill: 1,000 points
Quarter: -25 points	20 Dollar Bill: 2,000 points

Only the above coins and bills will be counted for points.

9. Table Locations:

Day 1, Thursday March 22nd 2012, 8 am-4 pm: Cal Poly Pomona, Bronco Commons

Day 2, Friday March 23rd 2012, 8 am-4 pm: Bonelli Park

10. Containers will be emptied as needed and points will be tallied at the end of each day. The total points for each school will be posted daily.
11. The school with the most **POINTS** total will be named the winner of this event.
